Water Baptisms in Acts

Reference	Who is Baptized?	Who Baptized?	Did Speaking in Tongues Occur? If so, when and who?
2:1-42	3000 feast attendees	Not specified Apostles?	The apostles spoke in languages know to feast attendees prior to water baptism.
8:4-17	People in Samaria	Philip – water baptism	It is not indicated if speaking in tongues occurred but the Apostles had to pray for and lay their hands on the people for them to receive the Holy Spirit.
8:25-40	Ethiopian eunuch	Philip	It is not recorded if the eunuch spoke in tongues but the Spirit immediately transported Philip to another location.
9:10-19 (cf. 22:12-16)	Saul / Paul	Ananias	Ananias tells Paul to repent and be baptized and receive the Holy Spirit, which he does but it is not indicated whether he spoke in tongues at that time.
10:1-48	Cornelius & his household	Peter	The people listening to Peter began speaking in tongues prior to water baptism.
16:11-15	Lydia & her household	Paul	It is not indicated if anyone spoke in tongues.
16:22-34	Philippian Jailer & his household	Paul & Silas	It is not indicated if anyone spoke in tongues.
18:5-11	Crispus & his household and many Corinthians	Paul, Silas, & Timothy	It is not indicated in the text if anyone spoke in tongues at the time of their baptism, but from 1 Corinthians it appears that some were able to speak in tongues later.
18:24-28	Ephesians	Apollos	They were only baptized into John's baptism of repentance.
19:1-7	12 Ephesian men	Paul	They were baptized in the name of Jesus and then Paul laid hands on them and they received the Holy Spirit and began speaking in tongues and prophesying.

Filled/Filling with the Holy Spirit

Acts 2:4 NASB And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit was giving them utterance.

Acts 4:8 NASB Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers and elders of the people,

Acts 4:31 NASB And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak the word of God with boldness.

Acts 9:17 NASB So Ananias departed and entered the house, and after laying his hands on him said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road by which you were coming, has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit."

Acts 13:9 NASB But Saul, who was also known as Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit, fixed his gaze on him,

- Paul is speaking to a false prophet

Acts 13:52 NASB And the disciples were continually filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

Full of the Holy Spirit

Acts 6:5 NASB The statement found approval with the whole congregation; and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, and Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch.

- First deacons

Acts 7:55 NASB But being full of the Holy Spirit, he gazed intently into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God;

- Stephen at the end of his testimony prior to being stoned

Acts 11:24 NASB for he was a good man, and full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And considerable numbers were brought to the Lord.

- Barnabas preaching in Antioch

“Holy Spirit Fell Upon”

Acts 10:44 NASB While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who were listening to the message.

- Peter speaking to Cornelius' house

Acts 11:15 NASB "And as I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell upon them just as He did upon us at the beginning.

- Peter relating the events at Cornelius' house to the church in Jerusalem
