

## Verses Related to a Humble Attitude

### Humble; Humbled; Humbles; Humbling; Humbly<sup>1</sup>

**Exodus 10:3 NASB** Moses and Aaron went to Pharaoh and said to him, "Thus says the LORD, the God of the Hebrews, 'How long will you refuse to **humble** yourself before Me? Let My people go, that they may serve Me.

**Leviticus 16:29 NASB** "This shall be a permanent statute for you: in the seventh month, on the tenth day of the month, you shall **humble** your souls and not do any work, whether the native, or the alien who sojourns among you;

**Leviticus 16:31 NASB** "It is to be a sabbath of solemn rest for you, that you may **humble** your souls; it is a permanent statute.

**Leviticus 23:27 NASB** "On exactly the tenth day of this seventh month is the day of atonement; it shall be a holy convocation for you, and you shall **humble** your souls and present an offering by fire to the LORD.

**Leviticus 23:29 NASB** "If there is any person who will not **humble** himself on this same day, he shall be cut off from his people.

**Leviticus 23:32 NASB** "It is to be a sabbath of complete rest to you, and you shall **humble** your souls; on the ninth of the month at evening, from evening until evening you shall keep your sabbath."

**Leviticus 26:41 NASB** I also was acting with hostility against them, to bring them into the land of their enemies--or if their uncircumcised heart becomes **humbled** so that they then make amends for their iniquity,

**Numbers 12:3 NASB** (Now the man Moses was very **humble**, more than any man who was on the face of the earth.)

**Numbers 29:7 NASB** 'Then on the tenth day of this seventh month you shall have a holy convocation, and you shall **humble** yourselves; you shall not do any work.

**Numbers 30:13 NASB** "Every vow and every binding oath to **humble** herself, her husband may confirm it or her husband may annul it.

**Deuteronomy 8:2 NASB** "You shall remember all the way which the LORD your God has led you in the wilderness these forty years, that He might **humble** you, testing you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not.

**Deuteronomy 8:3 NASB** "He **humbled** you and let you be hungry, and fed you with manna which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that He might make you understand that man does not live by bread alone, but man lives by everything that proceeds out of the mouth of the LORD.

**Deuteronomy 8:16 NASB** "In the wilderness He fed you manna which your fathers did not know, that He might **humble** you and that He might test you, to do good for you in the end.

**Deuteronomy 21:14 NASB** "It shall be, if you are not pleased with her, then you shall let her go wherever she wishes; but you shall certainly not sell her for money, you shall not mistreat her, because you have **humbled** her.

**2 Samuel 6:22 NASB** "I will be more lightly esteemed than this and will be **humble** in my own eyes, but with the maids of whom you have spoken, with them I will be distinguished."

## Verses Related to a Humble Attitude

- 1 Kings 21:29 NASB "Do you see how Ahab has humbled himself before Me? Because he has humbled himself before Me, I will not bring the evil in his days, *but* I will bring the evil upon his house in his son's days."
- 2 Kings 22:19 NASB because your heart was tender and you humbled yourself before the LORD when you heard what I spoke against this place and against its inhabitants that they should become a desolation and a curse, and you have torn your clothes and wept before Me, I truly have heard you," declares the LORD.
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 NASB and My people who are called by My name humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, will forgive their sin and will heal their land.
- 2 Chronicles 12:6 NASB So the princes of Israel and the king humbled themselves and said, "The LORD is righteous."
- 2 Chronicles 12:7 NASB When the LORD saw that they humbled themselves, the word of the LORD came to Shemaiah, saying, "They have humbled themselves *so* I will not destroy them, but I will grant them some *measure* of deliverance, and My wrath shall not be poured out on Jerusalem by means of Shishak.
- 2 Chronicles 12:12 NASB And when he humbled himself, the anger of the LORD turned away from him, so as not to destroy *him* completely; and also conditions were good in Judah.
- 2 Chronicles 28:19 NASB For the LORD humbled Judah because of Ahaz king of Israel, for he had brought about a lack of restraint in Judah and was very unfaithful to the LORD.
- 2 Chronicles 30:11 NASB Nevertheless some men of Asher, Manasseh and Zebulun humbled themselves and came to Jerusalem.
- 2 Chronicles 32:26 NASB However, Hezekiah humbled the pride of his heart, both he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the LORD did not come on them in the days of Hezekiah.
- 2 Chronicles 33:12 NASB When he was in distress, he entreated the LORD his God and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers.
- 2 Chronicles 33:19 NASB His prayer also and *how* God was entreated by him, and all his sin, his unfaithfulness, and the sites on which he built high places and erected the Asherim and the carved images, before he humbled himself, behold, they are written in the records of the Hozai.
- 2 Chronicles 33:23 NASB Moreover, he did not humble himself before the LORD as his father Manasseh had done, but Amon multiplied guilt.
- 2 Chronicles 34:27 NASB "Because your heart was tender and you humbled yourself before God when you heard His words against this place and against its inhabitants, and *because* you humbled yourself before Me, tore your clothes and wept before Me, I truly have heard you," declares the LORD.
- 2 Chronicles 36:12 NASB He did evil in the sight of the LORD his God; he did not humble himself before Jeremiah the prophet who spoke for the LORD.
- Ezra 8:21 NASB Then I proclaimed a fast there at the river of Ahava, that we might humble ourselves before our God to seek from Him a safe journey for us, our little ones, and all our possessions.
- Job 22:29 NASB "When you are cast down, you will speak with confidence, And the humble person He will save.
- Job 40:12 NASB "Look on everyone who is proud, *and* humble him, And tread down the wicked where

they stand.

**Psalms 10:17 NASB** O LORD, You have heard the desire of the **humble**; You will strengthen their heart, You will incline Your ear

**Psalms 25:9 NASB** He leads the **humble** in justice, And He teaches the **humble** His way.

**Psalms 34:2 NASB** My soul will make its boast in the LORD; The **humble** will hear it and rejoice.

**Psalms 35:13 NASB** But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing was sackcloth; I **humbled** my soul with fasting, And my prayer kept returning to my bosom.

**Psalms 37:11 NASB** But the **humble** will inherit the land And will delight themselves in abundant prosperity.

**Psalms 69:32 NASB** The **humble** have seen *it and* are glad; You who seek God, let your heart revive.

**Psalms 76:9 NASB** When God arose to judgment, To save all the **humble** of the earth. Selah.

**Psalms 107:12 NASB** Therefore He **humbled** their heart with labor; They stumbled and there was none to help.

**Psalms 113:6 NASB** Who **humbles** Himself to behold *The things that are* in heaven and in the earth?

**Proverbs 6:3 NASB** Do this then, my son, and deliver yourself; Since you have come into the hand of your neighbor, Go, **humble** yourself, and importune your neighbor.

**Proverbs 11:2 NASB** When pride comes, then comes dishonor, But with the **humble** is wisdom.

**Proverbs 16:19 NASB** It is better to be **humble** in spirit with the lowly Than to divide the spoil with the proud.

**Proverbs 29:23 NASB** A man's pride will bring him low, But a **humble** spirit will obtain honor.

**Ecclesiastes 10:6 NASB** folly is set in many exalted places while rich men sit in **humble** places.

**Isaiah 2:9 NASB** So the *common* man has been **humbled** And the man of *importance* has been abased, But do not forgive them.

**Isaiah 2:11 NASB** The proud look of man will be abased And the loftiness of man will be **humbled**, And the LORD alone will be exalted in that day.

**Isaiah 2:17 NASB** The pride of man will be **humbled** And the loftiness of men will be abased; And the LORD alone will be exalted in that day,

**Isaiah 5:15 NASB** So the *common* man will be **humbled** and the man of *importance* abased, The eyes of the proud also will be abased.

**Isaiah 58:3 NASB** 'Why have we fasted and You do not see? *Why* have we **humbled** ourselves and You do not notice?' Behold, on the day of your fast you find *your* desire, And drive hard all your workers.

**Isaiah 58:5 NASB** "Is it a fast like this which I choose, a day for a man to **humble** himself? Is it for bowing one's head like a reed And for spreading out sackcloth and ashes as a bed? Will you call this a fast, even an acceptable day to the LORD?"

**Isaiah 66:2 NASB** "For My hand made all these things, Thus all these things came into being," declares the LORD. "But to this one I will look, To him who is **humble** and contrite of spirit, and who trembles at My word.

**Ezekiel 22:10 NASB** "In you they have uncovered *their* fathers' nakedness; in you they have **humbled** her who was unclean in her menstrual impurity.

**Ezekiel 22:11 NASB** "One has committed abomination with his neighbor's wife and another has lewdly defiled his daughter-in-law. And another in you has **humbled** his sister, his father's daughter.

**Daniel 4:37 NASB** "Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise, exalt and honor the King of heaven, for all His works are true and His ways just, and He is able to **humble** those who walk in pride."

**Daniel 5:19 NASB** "Because of the grandeur which He bestowed on him, all the peoples, nations and *men of every* language feared and trembled before him; whomever he wished he killed and whomever he wished he spared alive; and whomever he wished he elevated and whomever he wished he **humbled**.

**Daniel 5:22 NASB** "Yet you, his son, Belshazzar, have not **humbled** your heart, even though you knew all this,

**Daniel 10:12 NASB** Then he said to me, "Do not be afraid, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart on understanding *this* and on **humbling** yourself before your God, your words were heard, and I have come in response to your words.

**Amos 2:7 NASB** "These who pant after the *very* dust of the earth on the head of the helpless Also turn aside the way of the **humble**; And a man and his father resort to the same girl In order to profane My holy name.

**Amos 8:4 NASB** Hear this, you who trample the needy, to do away with the **humble** of the land,

**Micah 6:8 NASB** He has told you, O man, what is good; And what does the LORD require of you But to do justice, to love kindness, And to walk **humbly** with your God?

**Zephaniah 2:3 NASB** Seek the LORD, All you **humble** of the earth Who have carried out His ordinances; Seek righteousness, seek **humility**. Perhaps you will be hidden In the day of the LORD'S anger.

**Zephaniah 3:12 NASB** "But I will leave among you A **humble** and lowly people, And they will take refuge in the name of the LORD.

**Zechariah 9:9 NASB** Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout *in triumph*, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king is coming to you; He is just and endowed with salvation, **Humble**, and mounted on a donkey, Even on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

**Matthew 11:29 NASB** "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and **humble** in heart, and YOU WILL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS.

**Matthew 18:4 NASB** "Whoever then **humbles** himself as this child, he is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

**Matthew 23:12 NASB** "Whoever exalts himself shall be humbled; and whoever **humbles** himself shall be exalted.

**Luke 1:48 NASB** "For He has had regard for the **humble** state of His bondservant; For behold, from this time on all generations will count me blessed.

**Luke 1:52 NASB** "He has brought down rulers from *their* thrones, And has exalted those who were **humble**.

**Luke 14:11 NASB** "For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who **humbles** himself will be exalted."

**Luke 18:14 NASB** "I tell you, this man went to his house justified rather than the other; for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but he who **humbles** himself will be exalted."

**2 Corinthians 11:7 NASB** Or did I commit a sin in **humbling** myself so that you might be exalted,

because I preached the gospel of God to you without charge?

**Philippians 2:8 NASB** Being found in appearance as a man, He **humbled** Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

**Philippians 3:21 NASB** who will transform the body of our **humble** state into conformity with the body of His glory, by the exertion of the power that He has even to subject all things to Himself.

**Philippians 4:12 NASB** I know how to get along with **humble** means, and I also know how to live in prosperity; in any and every circumstance I have learned the secret of being filled and going hungry, both of having abundance and suffering need.

**James 1:9 NASB** But the brother of **humble** circumstances is to glory in his high position;

**James 4:6 NASB** But He gives a greater grace. Therefore *it* says, "GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE **HUMBLE**."

**James 4:10 NASB** **humble** yourselves in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you.

**1 Peter 3:8 NASB** To sum up, all of you be harmonious, sympathetic, brotherly, kindhearted, and **humble** in spirit;

**1 Peter 5:5 NASB** You younger men, likewise, be subject to *your* elders; and all of you, clothe yourselves with **humility** toward one another, for GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE **HUMBLE**.

**1 Peter 5:6 NASB** Therefore **humble** yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the proper time,

**Proverbs 22:4 NASB** The reward of **humility** *and* the fear of the LORD Are riches, honor and life.

**Zephaniah 2:3 NASB** Seek the LORD, All you **humble** of the earth Who have carried out His ordinances; Seek righteousness, seek **humility**. Perhaps you will be hidden In the day of the LORD'S anger.

**Acts 20:19 NASB** serving the Lord with all **humility** and with tears and with trials which came upon me through the plots of the Jews;

**Ephesians 4:2 NASB** with all **humility** and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love,

**Philippians 2:3 NASB** Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with **humility** of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves;

**Colossians 3:12 NASB** So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, **humility**, gentleness and patience;

**James 1:21 NASB** Therefore, putting aside all filthiness and *all* that remains of wickedness, in **humility** receive the word implanted, which is able to save your souls.

**1 Peter 5:5 NASB** You younger men, likewise, be subject to *your* elders; and all of you, clothe yourselves with **humility** toward one another, for GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE **HUMBLE**.

### Contrite

**Psalms 51:17 NASB** The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; A broken and a **contrite** heart, O God, You will not despise.

**Isaiah 57:15 NASB** For thus says the high and exalted One Who lives forever, whose name is Holy, "I dwell *on* a high and holy place, And *also* with the contrite and lowly of spirit In order to revive the spirit of the lowly And to revive the heart of the **contrite**.

**Isaiah 66:2 NASB** "For My hand made all these things, Thus all these things came into being," declares the LORD. "But to this one I will look, To him who is **humble** and **contrite** of spirit, and who trembles at My word.

**Jeremiah 44:10 NASB** "But they have not become **contrite** even to this day, nor have they feared nor walked in My law or My statutes, which I have set before you and before your fathers."
