Uses of the phrase "will know that I" in Ezekiel

Sixty-five times the phrase "will know that I" is used in the book of Ezekiel to refer to God speaking to a group or individual about something that He would do or make happen so that they would know that He is the Lord and that He had done whatever it was that happened. These need to be read in their context to see the full impact of the statement but here is a list of verses that will help you find them.

Obviously God was wanting to make sure that the people got the message then, so it would make sense that *this still needs to be listened to today*.

5:13 'Thus My anger will be spent and I will satisfy My wrath on them, and I will be appeased; then they will know that I, the LORD, have spoken in My zeal when I have spent My wrath upon them.'	
6:7 "The slain will fall among you, and you will know that I am the LORD."	
6:10 "Then they will know that I am the LORD; I have not said in vain that I would inflict this disaster on them."	
6:13 "Then you will know that I am the LORD, when their slain are among their idols around their altars, on every high hill, on all the tops of the mountains, under every green tree and under every leafy oak--the places where they offered soothing aroma to all their idols."	
6:14 "So throughout all their habitations I will stretch out My hand against them and make the land more desolate and waste than the wilderness toward Diblah; thus they will know that I am the LORD."''	
7:4 'For My eye will have no pity on you, nor will I spare you, but I will bring your ways upon you, and your abominations will be among you; then you will know that I am the LORD!'

36:36 "Then the nations that are left round about you will know that I , the LORD, have rebuilt the ruined places <i>and</i> planted that which was desolate; I, the LORD, have spoken and will do it."	
36:38 "Like the flock for sacrifices, like the flock at Jerusalem during her appointed feasts, so will the waste cities be filled with flocks of men. Then they will know that I am the LORD. "	
37:6 "I will put sinews on you, make flesh grow back on you, cover you with skin and put breath in you that you may come alive; and you will know that I am the LORD. "	
37:13 "Then you will know that I am the LORD , when I have opened your graves and caused you to come up out of your graves, My people."

Exodus 14:4 "Thus I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and he will chase after them; and I will be honored through Pharaoh and all his army, and the Egyptians will know that I am the LORD. " And they did so."	
Exodus 14:18 "Then the Egyptians will know that I am the LORD , when I am honored through Pharaoh, through his chariots and his horsemen."

Joel 2:27 "Thus you <i>will know that I</i> am in the midst of Israel, And that I <i>am the LORD your God</i> , And there is no other; And My people will never be put to shame.	
Joel 3:17 Then you <i>will know that I</i> am the LORD your God, Dwelling in Zion, My holy mountain. So Jerusalem will be holy, And strangers will pass through it no more.
