Exodus 4:12 NASB "Now then go, and I, even I, will be with your mouth, and **teach** you what you are to say."

Exodus 4:15 NASB "You are to speak to him and put the words in his mouth; and I, even I, will be with your mouth and his mouth, and I will **teach** you what you are to do.

Exodus 18:20 NASB then **teach** them the statutes and the laws, and make known to them the way in which they are to walk and the work they are to do.

Exodus 35:34 NASB "He also has put in his heart to **teach**, both he and Oholiab, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan.

Deuteronomy 6:1 NASB "Now this is the commandment, the statutes and the judgments which the LORD your God has commanded *me* to **teach** you, that you might do *them* in the land where you are going over to possess it,

Deuteronomy 6:7 NASB "You shall **teach** them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up.

Deuteronomy 11:19 NASB "You shall **teach** them to your sons, talking of them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road and when you lie down and when you rise up.

Deuteronomy 17:10 NASB "You shall do according to the terms of the verdict which they declare to you from *that* place which the LORD chooses; and you shall be careful to observe according to all that they **teach** you.

Deuteronomy 17:11 NASB "According to the terms of the law which they **teach** you, and according to the verdict which they tell you, you shall do; you shall not turn aside from the word which they declare to you, to the right or the left.

Deuteronomy 20:18 NASB so that they may not **teach** you to do according to all their detestable things which they have done for their gods, so that you would sin against the LORD your God.

Deuteronomy 24:8 NASB "Be careful against an infection of leprosy, that you diligently observe and do according to all that the Levitical priests **teach** you; as I have commanded them, so you shall be careful to do.

Deuteronomy 31:19 NASB "Now therefore, write this song for yourselves, and **teach** it to the sons of Israel; put it on their lips, so that this song may be a witness for Me against the sons of Israel.

Deuteronomy 33:10 NASB "They shall **teach** Your ordinances to Jacob, And Your law to Israel. They shall put incense before You, And whole burnt offerings on Your altar.

- Judges 13:8 NASB Then Manoah entreated the LORD and said, "O Lord, please let the man of God whom You have sent come to us again that he may **teach** us what to do for the boy who is to be born."
- 2 Samuel 1:18 NASB and he told *them* to **teach** the sons of Judah *the song of* the bow; behold, it is written in the book of Jashar.
- 1 Kings 8:36 NASB then hear in heaven and forgive the sin of Your servants and of Your people Israel, indeed, **teach** them the good way in which they should walk. And send rain on Your land, which You have given Your people for an inheritance.
- 2 Kings 17:27 NASB Then the king of Assyria commanded, saying, "Take there one of the priests whom you carried away into exile and let him go and live there; and let him **teach** them the custom of the god of the land."

- Job 6:24 NASB "**teach** me, and I will be silent; And show me how I have erred.

- Psalms 27:11 NASB **teach** me Your way, O LORD, And lead me in a level path Because of my foes.
- Psalms 32:8 NASB I will **instruct** you and **teach** you in the way which you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you.
- Psalms 34:11 NASB Come, you children, listen to me; I will **teach** you the fear of the LORD.
- Psalms 45:4 NASB And in Your majesty ride on victoriously, For the cause of truth and meekness *and* righteousness; Let Your right hand **teach** You awesome things.

Psalms 86:11 NASB **teach** me Your way, O LORD; I will walk in Your truth; Unite my heart to fear Your name.
Psalms 90:12 NASB So **teach** us to number our days, That we may present to You a heart of wisdom.
Psalms 94:12 NASB Blessed is the man whom You chasten, O LORD, And whom You **teach** out of Your law;
Psalms 105:22 NASB To imprison his princes at will, That he might **teach** his elders wisdom.
Psalms 119:12 NASB Blessed are You, O LORD; **teach** me Your statutes.
Psalms 119:26 NASB I have told of my ways, and You have answered me; **teach** me Your statutes.
Psalms 119:33 NASB **h He.** **teach** me, O LORD, the way of Your statutes, And I shall observe it to the end.
Psalms 119:64 NASB The earth is full of Your lovingkindness, O LORD; **teach** me Your statutes.
Psalms 119:66 NASB **teach** me good discernment and knowledge, For I believe in Your commandments.

Psalms 143:10 NASB **teach** me to do Your will, For You are my God; Let Your good Spirit lead me on level ground.
Proverbs 9:9 NASB Give *instruction* to a wise man and he will be still wiser, **teach** a righteous man and he will increase *his* learning.
Isaiah 2:3 NASB And many peoples will come and say, "Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, To the house of the God of Jacob; That He may **teach** us concerning His ways And that we may walk in His paths." For the law will go forth from Zion And the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.
Isaiah 28:9 NASB "To whom would He **teach** knowledge, And to whom would He interpret the message? Those *just* weaned from milk? Those *just* taken from the breast?
Jeremiah 9:20 NASB Now hear the word of the LORD, O you women, And let your ear receive the word of His mouth; **teach** your daughters wailing, And everyone her neighbor a dirge.
Jeremiah 31:34 NASB "They will not **teach** again, each man his neighbor and each man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they will all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them," declares the LORD, "for I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."
Ezekiel 44:23 NASB "Moreover, they shall **teach** My people *the difference* between the holy and the profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean.
Daniel 1:4 NASB youths in whom was no defect, who were good-looking, showing intelligence in every *branch of* wisdom, endowed with understanding and discerning knowledge, and who had ability for serving in the king's court; and *he ordered him to* **teach** them the literature and language of the Chaldeans.
Micah 4:2 NASB Many nations will come and say, "Come and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD And to the house of the God of Jacob, That He may **teach** us about His ways And that we may walk in His paths." For from Zion will go forth the law, Even the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

Matthew 5:2 NASB He opened His mouth and *began* to **teach** them, saying,

Matthew 11:1 NASB When Jesus had finished giving instructions to His twelve disciples, He departed from there to **teach** and preach in their cities.

Matthew 22:16 NASB And they *sent their disciples to Him, along with the Herodians, saying, "**teacher**, we know that You are truthful and **teach** the way of God in truth, and defer to no one; for You are not partial to any.

Mark 1:21 NASB They *went into Capernaum; and immediately on the Sabbath He entered the synagogue and *began* to **teach**.

Mark 4:1 NASB He began to **teach** again by the sea. And such a very large crowd gathered to Him that He got into a boat in the sea and sat down; and the whole crowd was by the sea on the land.

Mark 6:2 NASB When the Sabbath came, He began to **teach** in the synagogue; and the many listeners were astonished, saying, "Where did this man *get* these things, and what is *this* wisdom given to Him, and such miracles as these performed by His hands?

Mark 6:34 NASB When Jesus went ashore, He saw a large crowd, and He felt compassion for them because they were like sheep without a shepherd; and He began to **teach** them many things.

Mark 8:31 NASB And He began to **teach** them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.

Mark 10:1 NASB Getting up, He *went from there to the region of Judea and beyond the Jordan; crowds *gathered around Him again, and, according to His custom, He once more *began* to **teach** them.

Mark 11:17 NASB And He *began* to **teach** and say to them, "**Is it not written, 'MY HOUSE SHALL BE CALLED A HOUSE OF PRAYER FOR ALL THE NATIONS'? But you have made it a ROBBERS' DEN.**"

Mark 12:14 NASB They *came and *said to Him, "**teacher**, we know that You are truthful and defer to no one; for You are not partial to any, but **teach** the way of God in truth. Is it lawful to pay a poll-tax to Caesar, or not?

Luke 11:1 NASB It happened that while Jesus was praying in a certain place, after He had finished, one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, **teach** us to pray just as John also **taught** his disciples."

Luke 12:12 NASB **for the Holy Spirit will **teach** you in that very hour what you ought to say."**

Luke 20:21 NASB They questioned Him, saying, "**teacher**, we know that You speak and **teach** correctly, and You are not partial to any, but **teach** the way of God in truth.

John 7:14 NASB But when it was now the midst of the feast Jesus went up into the temple, and *began* to **teach**.

John 7:35 NASB The Jews then said to one another, "Where does this man intend to go that we will not find Him? He is not intending to go to the Dispersion among the Greeks, and **teach** the Greeks, is He?

John 8:2 NASB Early in the morning He came again into the temple, and all the people were coming to Him; and He sat down and *began* to **teach** them.

John 14:26 NASB **"But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will **teach** you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.**

Acts 1:1 NASB The first account I composed, Theophilus, about all that Jesus began to do and **teach**,

Acts 4:18 NASB And when they had summoned them, they commanded them not to speak or **teach** at all in the name of Jesus.

Acts 5:21 NASB Upon hearing *this*, they entered into the temple about daybreak and *began* to **teach**. Now when the high priest and his associates came, they called the Council together, even all the Senate of the sons of Israel, and sent *orders* to the prison house for them to be brought.

Romans 2:21 NASB you, therefore, who **teach** another, do you not **teach** yourself? You who preach that one shall not steal, do you steal?

1 Corinthians 4:17 NASB For this reason I have sent to you Timothy, who is my beloved and faithful

child in the Lord, and he will remind you of my ways which are in Christ, just as I **teach** everywhere in every church.

- 1 Corinthians 11:14 NASB Does not even nature itself **teach** you that if a man has long hair, it is a dishonor to him,
- 1 Timothy 1:3 NASB As I urged you upon my departure for Macedonia, remain on at Ephesus so that you may **instruct** certain men not to **teach** strange doctrines,
- 1 Timothy 2:12 NASB But I do not allow a woman to **teach** or exercise authority over a man, but to remain quiet.
- 1 Timothy 3:2 NASB An overseer, then, must be above reproach, the husband of one wife, temperate, prudent, respectable, hospitable, able to **teach**,
- 1 Timothy 4:11 NASB Prescribe and **teach** these things.
- 1 Timothy 6:2 NASB Those who have believers as their masters must not be disrespectful to them because they are brethren, but must serve them all the more, because those who partake of the benefit are believers and beloved. **teach** and preach these *principles*.
- 2 Timothy 2:2 NASB The things which you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, entrust these to faithful men who will be able to **teach** others also.
- 2 Timothy 2:24 NASB The Lord's bond-servant must not be quarrelsome, but be kind to all, able to **teach**, patient when wronged,
- Titus 1:11 NASB who must be silenced because they are upsetting whole families, **teaching** things they should not **teach** for the sake of sordid gain.
- Hebrews 5:12 NASB For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you have need again for someone to **teach** you the elementary principles of the oracles of God, and you have come to need milk and not solid food.
- Hebrews 8:11 NASB "AND THEY SHALL NOT **teach** EVERYONE HIS FELLOW CITIZEN, AND EVERYONE HIS BROTHER, SAYING, 'KNOW THE LORD,' FOR ALL WILL KNOW ME, FROM THE LEAST TO THE GREATEST OF THEM.
- 1 John 2:27 NASB As for you, the anointing which you received from Him abides in you, and you have no need for anyone to **teach** you; but as His anointing **teaches** you about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has **taught** you, you abide in Him.

- Matthew 5:19 NASB "Whoever then annuls one of the least of these commandments, and **teaches** others *to do* the same, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever keeps and **teaches** them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.
- Romans 12:7 NASB if service, in his serving; or he who **teaches**, in his **teaching**;

Deuteronomy 32:2 NASB "Let my teaching drop as the rain, My speech distill as the dew, As the droplets on the fresh grass And as the showers on the herb.

2 Chronicles 15:3 NASB "For many days Israel was without the true God and without a teaching priest and without law.

Job 11:4 NASB "For you have said, 'My teaching is pure, And I am innocent in your eyes.'

Proverbs 1:8 NASB Hear, my son, your father's instruction And do not forsake your mother's teaching;

Proverbs 3:1 NASB My son, do not forget my teaching, But let your heart keep my commandments;

Proverbs 4:2 NASB For I give you sound teaching; Do not abandon my instruction.

Proverbs 6:20 NASB My son, observe the commandment of your father And do not forsake the teaching of your mother;

Proverbs 6:23 NASB For the commandment is a lamp and the teaching is light; And reproofs for discipline are the way of life

Proverbs 7:2 NASB Keep my commandments and live, And my teaching as the apple of your eye.

Proverbs 13:14 NASB The teaching of the wise is a fountain of life, To turn aside from the snares of death.

Proverbs 31:26 NASB She opens her mouth in wisdom, And the teaching of kindness is on her tongue.

Jeremiah 32:33 NASB "They have turned their back to Me and not their face; though I taught them, teaching again and again, they would not listen and receive instruction.

Matthew 4:23 NASB Jesus was going throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness among the people.

Matthew 7:28 NASB When Jesus had finished these words, the crowds were amazed at His teaching;

Matthew 7:29 NASB for He was teaching them as one having authority, and not as their scribes.

Matthew 9:35 NASB Jesus was going through all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness.

Matthew 13:54 NASB He came to His hometown and began teaching them in their synagogue, so that they were astonished, and said, "Where did this man get this wisdom and these miraculous powers?"

Matthew 15:9 NASB 'BUT IN VAIN DO THEY WORSHIP ME, teaching AS DOCTRINES THE PRECEPTS OF MEN.'

Matthew 16:12 NASB Then they understood that He did not say to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the teaching of the Pharisees and Sadducees.

Matthew 21:23 NASB When He entered the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people came to Him while He was teaching, and said, "By what authority are You doing these things, and who gave You this authority?"

Matthew 22:33 NASB When the crowds heard *this*, they were astonished at His **teaching**.

Matthew 26:55 NASB At that time Jesus said to the crowds, "Have you come out with swords and clubs to arrest Me as *you would* against a robber? Every day I used to sit in the temple **teaching** and you did not seize Me.

Matthew 28:20 NASB **teaching** them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Mark 1:22 NASB They were amazed at His **teaching**; for He was **teaching** them as *one* having authority, and not as the scribes.

Mark 1:27 NASB They were all amazed, so that they debated among themselves, saying, "What is this? A new **teaching** with authority! He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey Him."

Mark 2:13 NASB And He went out again by the seashore; and all the people were coming to Him, and He was **teaching** them.

Mark 4:2 NASB And He was **teaching** them many things in parables, and was saying to them in His **teaching**,

Mark 6:6 NASB And He wondered at their unbelief. And He was going around the villages **teaching**.

Mark 7:7 NASB 'BUT IN VAIN DO THEY WORSHIP ME, **teaching** AS DOCTRINES THE PRECEPTS OF MEN.'

Mark 9:31 NASB For He was **teaching** His disciples and telling them, "The Son of Man is to be delivered into the hands of men, and they will kill Him; and when He has been killed, He will rise three days later."

Mark 11:18 NASB The chief priests and the scribes heard *this*, and *began* seeking how to destroy Him; for they were afraid of Him, for the whole crowd was astonished at His **teaching**.

Mark 12:38 NASB In His **teaching** He was saying: "Beware of the scribes who like to walk around in long robes, and *like* respectful greetings in the market places,

Mark 14:49 NASB "Every day I was with you in the temple **teaching**, and you did not seize Me; but *this* has taken place to fulfill the Scriptures."

Luke 4:15 NASB And He *began* **teaching** in their synagogues and was praised by all.

Luke 4:31 NASB And He came down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and He was **teaching** them on the Sabbath;

Luke 4:32 NASB and they were amazed at His **teaching**, for His message was with authority.

Luke 5:3 NASB And He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little way from the land. And He sat down and *began* **teaching** the people from the boat.

Luke 5:17 NASB One day He was **teaching**; and there were *some* Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting *there*, who had come from every village of Galilee and Judea and *from* Jerusalem; and the power of the Lord was *present* for Him to perform healing.

Luke 6:6 NASB On another Sabbath He entered the synagogue and was **teaching**; and there was a man there whose right hand was withered.

Luke 13:10 NASB And He was **teaching** in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath.

Luke 13:22 NASB And He was passing through from one city and village to another, **teaching**, and proceeding on His way to Jerusalem.

Luke 19:47 NASB And He was **teaching** daily in the temple; but the chief priests and the scribes and the leading men among the people were trying to destroy Him,

Luke 20:1 NASB On one of the days while He was **teaching** the people in the temple and preaching the gospel, the chief priests and the scribes with the elders confronted *Him*,

Luke 21:37 NASB Now during the day He was **teaching** in the temple, but at evening He would go out and spend the night on the mount that is called Olivet.

Luke 23:5 NASB But they kept on insisting, saying, "He stirs up the people, **teaching** all over Judea, starting from Galilee even as far as this place."

John 7:16 NASB So Jesus answered them and said, "My **teaching** is not Mine, but His who sent Me.

John 7:17 NASB "If anyone is willing to do His will, he will know of the **teaching**, whether it is of God or whether I speak from Myself.

John 7:28 NASB Then Jesus cried out in the temple, **teaching** and saying, "You both know Me and know where I am from; and I have not come of Myself, but He who sent Me is true, whom you do not know.

John 9:34 NASB They answered him, "You were born entirely in sins, and are you **teaching** us?" So they put him out.

John 18:19 NASB The high priest then questioned Jesus about His disciples, and about His **teaching**.

Acts 2:42 NASB They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' **teaching** and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

Acts 4:2 NASB being greatly disturbed because they were **teaching** the people and proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection from the dead.

Acts 5:25 NASB But someone came and reported to them, "The men whom you put in prison are standing in the temple and **teaching** the people!"

Acts 5:28 NASB saying, "We gave you strict orders not to continue **teaching** in this name, and yet, you have filled Jerusalem with your **teaching** and intend to bring this man's blood upon us."

Acts 5:42 NASB And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they kept right on **teaching** and preaching Jesus *as* the Christ.

Acts 13:12 NASB Then the proconsul believed when he saw what had happened, being amazed at the **teaching** of the Lord.

Acts 15:1 NASB Some men came down from Judea and *began* **teaching** the brethren, "Unless you are circumcised according to the custom of Moses, you cannot be saved."

Acts 15:35 NASB But Paul and Barnabas stayed in Antioch, **teaching** and preaching with many others also, the word of the Lord.

Acts 17:19 NASB And they took him and brought him to the Areopagus, saying, "May we know what this new **teaching** is which you are proclaiming?

Acts 18:11 NASB And he settled *there* a year and six months, **teaching** the word of God among them.

Acts 18:25 NASB This man had been **instructed** in the way of the Lord; and being fervent in spirit, he was speaking and **teaching** accurately the things concerning Jesus, being acquainted only with the baptism of John;

Acts 20:20 NASB how I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable, and **teaching** you publicly and from house to house,

Acts 21:21 NASB and they have been told about you, that you are **teaching** all the Jews who are among the Gentiles to forsake Moses, telling them not to circumcise their children nor to walk according to the customs.

Acts 28:31 NASB preaching the kingdom of God and **teaching** concerning the Lord Jesus Christ with all openness, unhindered.

Romans 6:17 NASB But thanks be to God that though you were slaves of sin, you became obedient from the heart to that form of **teaching** to which you were committed,

Romans 12:7 NASB if service, in his serving; or he who **teaches**, in his **teaching**;

Romans 16:17 NASB Now I urge you, brethren, keep your eye on those who cause dissensions and hindrances contrary to the **teaching** which you learned, and turn away from them.

1 Corinthians 14:6 NASB But now, brethren, if I come to you speaking in tongues, what will I profit you unless I speak to you either by way of revelation or of knowledge or of prophecy or of **teaching**?

1 Corinthians 14:26 NASB What is *the outcome* then, brethren? When you assemble, each one has a psalm, has a **teaching**, has a revelation, has a tongue, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification.

- Colossians 1:28 NASB We proclaim Him, admonishing every man and **teaching** every man with all wisdom, so that we may present every man complete in Christ.
- Colossians 3:16 NASB Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom **teaching** and admonishing one another with psalms *and* hymns *and* spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.
- 1 Timothy 1:10 NASB and immoral men and homosexuals and kidnappers and liars and perjurers, and whatever else is contrary to sound **teaching**,
- 1 Timothy 4:13 NASB Until I come, give attention to the *public* reading of *Scripture*, to exhortation and **teaching**.
- 1 Timothy 4:16 NASB Pay close attention to yourself and to your **teaching**; persevere in these things, for as you do this you will ensure salvation both for yourself and for those who hear you.
- 1 Timothy 5:17 NASB The elders who rule well are to be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who work hard at preaching and **teaching**.
- 2 Timothy 3:10 NASB Now you followed my **teaching**, conduct, purpose, faith, patience, love, perseverance,
- 2 Timothy 3:16 NASB All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for **teaching**, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness;
- 2 Timothy 4:15 NASB Be on guard against him yourself, for he vigorously opposed our **teaching**.
- Titus 1:9 NASB holding fast the faithful word which is in accordance with the **teaching**, so that he will be able both to exhort in sound doctrine and to refute those who contradict.
- Titus 1:11 NASB who must be silenced because they are upsetting whole families, **teaching** things they should not **teach** for the sake of sordid gain.
- Titus 2:3 NASB Older women likewise are to be reverent in their behavior, not malicious gossips nor enslaved to much wine, **teaching** what is good,
- Hebrews 6:1 NASB Therefore leaving the elementary **teaching** about the Christ, let us press on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God,
- 2 John 1:9 NASB Anyone who goes too far and does not abide in the **teaching** of Christ, does not have God; the one who abides in the **teaching**, he has both the Father and the Son.
- 2 John 1:10 NASB If anyone comes to you and does not bring this **teaching**, do not receive him into *your* house, and do not give him a greeting;
- Revelation 2:14 NASB 'But I have a few things against you, because you have there some who hold the **teaching** of Balaam, who kept **teaching** Balak to put a stumbling block before the sons of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols and to commit *acts of* immorality.
- Revelation 2:15 NASB 'So you also have some who in the same way hold the **teaching** of the Nicolaitans.
- Revelation 2:24 NASB 'But I say to you, the rest who are in Thyatira, who do not hold this **teaching**, who have not known the deep things of Satan, as they call them--I place no other burden on you.

Taught [43 verses, 46 matches]

- Deuteronomy 4:5 NASB "See, I have **taught** you statutes and judgments just as the LORD my God commanded me, that you should do thus in the land where you are entering to possess it.
- Deuteronomy 31:22 NASB So Moses wrote this song the same day, and **taught** it to the sons of Israel.
- Judges 3:2 NASB only in order that the generations of the sons of Israel might be **taught** war, those who had not experienced it formerly).
- 2 Kings 17:28 NASB So one of the priests whom they had carried away into exile from Samaria came and lived at Bethel, and **taught** them how they should fear the LORD.
- 2 Chronicles 17:9 NASB They **taught** in Judah, *having* the book of the law of the LORD with them; and they went throughout all the cities of Judah and **taught** among the people.

- 2 Chronicles 35:3 NASB He also said to the Levites who **taught** all Israel *and* who were holy to the LORD, "Put the holy ark in the house which Solomon the son of David king of Israel built; it will be a burden on *your* shoulders no longer. Now serve the LORD your God and His people Israel.
- Nehemiah 8:9 NASB Then Nehemiah, who was the governor, and Ezra the priest *and* scribe, and the Levites who **taught** the people said to all the people, "This day is holy to the LORD your God; do not mourn or weep." For all the people were weeping when they heard the words of the law.
- Psalms 71:17 NASB O God, You have **taught** me from my youth, And I still declare Your wondrous deeds.
- Psalms 119:102 NASB I have not turned aside from Your ordinances, For You Yourself have **taught** me.
- Proverbs 4:4 NASB Then he **taught** me and said to me, "Let your heart hold fast my words; Keep my commandments and live;
- Proverbs 22:19 NASB So that your trust may be in the LORD, I have **taught** you today, even you.
- Proverbs 31:1 NASB The words of King Lemuel, the oracle which his mother **taught** him:
- Ecclesiastes 12:9 NASB In addition to being a wise man, the Preacher also **taught** the people knowledge; and he pondered, searched out and arranged many proverbs.
- Isaiah 40:14 NASB With whom did He consult and *who* gave Him understanding? And *who* **taught** Him in the path of justice and **taught** Him knowledge And informed Him of the way of understanding?
- Isaiah 54:13 NASB "All your sons will be **taught** of the LORD; And the well-being of your sons will be great.
- Jeremiah 2:33 NASB "How well you prepare your way To seek love! Therefore even the wicked women You have **taught** your ways.
- Jeremiah 9:5 NASB "Everyone deceives his neighbor And does not speak the truth, They have **taught** their tongue to speak lies; They weary themselves committing iniquity.
- Jeremiah 9:14 NASB but have walked after the stubbornness of their heart and after the Baals, as their fathers **taught** them,"
- Jeremiah 12:16 NASB "Then if they will really learn the ways of My people, to swear by My name, 'As the LORD lives,' even as they **taught** My people to swear by Baal, they will be built up in the midst of My people.
- Jeremiah 13:21 NASB "What will you say when He appoints over you-- And you yourself had **taught** them-- Former companions to be head over you? Will not pangs take hold of you Like a woman in childbirth?
- Jeremiah 32:33 NASB "They have turned *their* back to Me and not *their* face; though I **taught** them, **teaching** again and again, they would not listen and receive instruction.
- Ezekiel 22:26 NASB "Her priests have done violence to My law and have profaned My holy things; they have made no distinction between the holy and the profane, and they have not **taught** the difference between the unclean and the clean; and they hide their eyes from My sabbaths, and I am profaned among them.
- Hosea 11:3 NASB Yet it is I who **taught** Ephraim to walk, I took them in My arms; But they did not know that I healed them.
- Mark 6:30 NASB The apostles *gathered together with Jesus; and they reported to Him all that they had done and **taught**.
- Mark 12:35 NASB And Jesus *began* to say, as He **taught** in the temple, "**How is it that the scribes say that the Christ is the son of David?**"
- Luke 1:4 NASB so that you may know the exact truth about the things you have been **taught**.
- Luke 11:1 NASB It happened that while Jesus was praying in a certain place, after He had finished, one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, **teach** us to pray just as John also **taught** his disciples."
- Luke 13:26 NASB "Then you will begin to say, 'We ate and drank in Your presence, and You **taught** in our streets';
- John 6:45 NASB "It is written in the prophets, '**AND THEY SHALL ALL BE taught OF GOD.**' Everyone who

has heard and learned from the Father, comes to Me.

John 6:59 NASB These things He said in the synagogue as He **taught** in Capernaum.

John 8:20 NASB These words He spoke in the treasury, as He **taught** in the temple; and no one seized Him, because His hour had not yet come.

John 8:28 NASB So Jesus said, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am *He*, and I do nothing on My own initiative, but I speak these things as the Father **taught** Me.

John 18:20 NASB Jesus answered him, "I have spoken openly to the world; I always **taught** in synagogues and in the temple, where all the Jews come together; and I spoke nothing in secret.

Acts 11:26 NASB and when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch. And for an entire year they met with the church and **taught** considerable numbers; and the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch.

1 Corinthians 2:13 NASB which things we also speak, not in words **taught** by human wisdom, but in those **taught** by the Spirit, combining spiritual *thoughts* with spiritual *words*.

Galatians 1:12 NASB For I neither received it from man, nor was I **taught** it, but *I received it* through a revelation of Jesus Christ.

Galatians 6:6 NASB The one who is **taught** the word is to share all good things with the one who **teaches** him.

Ephesians 4:21 NASB if indeed you have heard Him and have been **taught** in Him, just as truth is in Jesus,

1 Thessalonians 4:9 NASB Now as to the love of the brethren, you have no need for *anyone* to write to you, for you yourselves are **taught** by God to love one another;

2 Thessalonians 2:15 NASB So then, brethren, stand firm and hold to the traditions which you were **taught**, whether by word *of mouth* or by letter from us.

1 Timothy 1:20 NASB Among these are Hymenaeus and Alexander, whom I have handed over to Satan, so that they will be **taught** not to blaspheme.

2 Peter 3:16 NASB as also in all *his* letters, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand, which the untaught and unstable distort, as *they do* also the rest of the Scriptures, to their own destruction.

1 John 2:27 NASB As for you, the anointing which you received from Him abides in you, and you have no need for anyone to **teach** you; but as His anointing **teaches** you about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has **taught** you, you abide in Him.

Teacher [56 verses, 58 matches]

1 Chronicles 25:8 NASB They cast lots for their duties, all alike, the small as well as the great, the **teacher** *as well* as the pupil.

Job 36:22 NASB "Behold, God is exalted in His power; Who is a **teacher** like Him?

Isaiah 30:20 NASB Although the Lord has given you bread of privation and water of oppression, *He*, your **teacher** will no longer hide Himself, but your eyes will behold your **teacher**.

Habakkuk 2:18 NASB "What profit is the idol when its maker has carved it, *Or* an image, a **teacher** of falsehood? For *its* maker trusts in his *own* handiwork When he fashions speechless idols.

Habakkuk 2:19 NASB "Woe to him who says to a *piece of wood*, 'Awake!' To a mute stone, 'Arise!' *And* that is *your* **teacher**? Behold, it is overlaid with gold and silver, And there is no breath at all inside it.

Matthew 8:19 NASB Then a scribe came and said to Him, "**teacher**, I will follow You wherever You go."

Matthew 9:11 NASB When the Pharisees saw *this*, they said to His disciples, "Why is your **teacher** eating with the tax collectors and sinners?"

Matthew 10:24 NASB "A disciple is not above his **teacher**, nor a slave above his master.

Matthew 10:25 NASB "It is enough for the disciple that he become like his **teacher**, and the slave like his master. If they have called the head of the house Beelzebul, how much more *will they malign the members of his household!*

Matthew 12:38 NASB Then some of the scribes and Pharisees said to Him, "**teacher**, we want to see a sign from You."

Matthew 17:24 NASB When they came to Capernaum, those who collected the two-drachma *tax* came to Peter and said, "Does your **teacher** not pay the two-drachma *tax*?"

Matthew 19:16 NASB And someone came to Him and said, "**teacher**, what good thing shall I do that I may obtain eternal life?"

Matthew 22:16 NASB And they *sent their disciples to Him, along with the Herodians, saying, "**teacher**, we know that You are truthful and teach the way of God in truth, and defer to no one; for You are not partial to any.

Matthew 22:24 NASB asking, "**teacher**, Moses said, 'IF A MAN DIES HAVING NO CHILDREN, HIS BROTHER AS NEXT OF KIN SHALL MARRY HIS WIFE, AND RAISE UP CHILDREN FOR HIS BROTHER.'

Matthew 22:36 NASB "**teacher**, which is the great commandment in the Law?"

Matthew 23:8 NASB "*But do not be called Rabbi; for One is your **teacher**, and you are all brothers.*

Matthew 26:18 NASB And He said, "*Go into the city to a certain man, and say to him, 'The **teacher** says, 'My time is near; I *am to keep the Passover at your house with My disciples.*'"*

Mark 4:38 NASB Jesus Himself was in the stern, asleep on the cushion; and they *woke Him and *said to Him, "**teacher**, do You not care that we are perishing?"

Mark 5:35 NASB While He was still speaking, they *came from the *house of* the synagogue official, saying, "Your daughter has died; why trouble the **teacher** anymore?"

Mark 9:17 NASB And one of the crowd answered Him, "**teacher**, I brought You my son, possessed with a spirit which makes him mute;

Mark 9:38 NASB John said to Him, "**teacher**, we saw someone casting out demons in Your name, and we tried to prevent him because he was not following us."

Mark 10:17 NASB As He was setting out on a journey, a man ran up to Him and knelt before Him, and asked Him, "Good **teacher**, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?"

Mark 10:20 NASB And he said to Him, "**teacher**, I have kept all these things from my youth up."

Mark 10:35 NASB James and John, the two sons of Zebedee, *came up to Jesus, saying, "**teacher**, we want You to do for us whatever we ask of You."

Mark 12:14 NASB They *came and *said to Him, "**teacher**, we know that You are truthful and defer to no one; for You are not partial to any, but teach the way of God in truth. Is it lawful to pay a poll-tax to Caesar, or not?

Mark 12:19 NASB "**teacher**, Moses wrote for us that IF A MAN'S BROTHER DIES and leaves behind a wife AND LEAVES NO CHILD, HIS BROTHER SHOULD MARRY THE WIFE AND RAISE UP CHILDREN TO HIS BROTHER.

Mark 12:32 NASB The scribe said to Him, "Right, **teacher**; You have truly stated that HE IS ONE, AND THERE IS NO ONE ELSE BESIDES HIM;

Mark 13:1 NASB As He was going out of the temple, one of His disciples *said to Him, "**teacher**, behold what wonderful stones and what wonderful buildings!"

Mark 14:14 NASB *and wherever he enters, say to the owner of the house, 'The **teacher** says, 'Where is My guest room in which I may eat the Passover with My disciples?'*

Luke 3:12 NASB And *some* tax collectors also came to be baptized, and they said to him, "**teacher**, what shall we do?"

Luke 6:40 NASB "*A pupil is not above his **teacher**; but everyone, after he has been fully trained, will be like his **teacher**.*

Luke 7:40 NASB And Jesus answered him, "*Simon, I have something to say to you.*" And he replied, "Say

it, **teacher**."

Luke 8:49 NASB While He was still speaking, someone *came from *the house of* the synagogue official, saying, "Your daughter has died; do not trouble the **teacher** anymore."

Luke 9:38 NASB And a man from the crowd shouted, saying, "**teacher**, I beg You to look at my son, for he is my only *boy*,

Luke 10:25 NASB And a lawyer stood up and put Him to the test, saying, "**teacher**, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?"

Luke 11:45 NASB One of the lawyers *said to Him in reply, "**teacher**, when You say this, You insult us too."

Luke 12:13 NASB Someone in the crowd said to Him, "**teacher**, tell my brother to divide the *family* inheritance with me."

Luke 18:18 NASB A ruler questioned Him, saying, "Good **teacher**, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?"

Luke 19:39 NASB Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Him, "**teacher**, rebuke Your disciples."

Luke 20:21 NASB They questioned Him, saying, "**teacher**, we know that You speak and teach correctly, and You are not partial to any, but teach the way of God in truth.

Luke 20:28 NASB and they questioned Him, saying, "**teacher**, Moses wrote for us that IF A MAN'S BROTHER DIES, having a wife, AND HE IS CHILDLESS, HIS BROTHER SHOULD MARRY THE WIFE AND RAISE UP CHILDREN TO HIS BROTHER.

Luke 20:39 NASB Some of the scribes answered and said, "**teacher**, You have spoken well."

Luke 21:7 NASB They questioned Him, saying, "**teacher**, when therefore will these things happen? And what *will be* the sign when these things are about to take place?"

Luke 22:11 NASB "*And you shall say to the owner of the house, 'The **teacher** says to you, 'Where is the guest room in which I may eat the Passover with My disciples?'*"

John 1:38 NASB And Jesus turned and saw them following, and *said to them, "*What do you seek?*" They said to Him, "Rabbi (which translated means **teacher**), where are You staying?"

John 3:2 NASB this man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You have come from God *as a **teacher***; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him."

John 3:10 NASB Jesus answered and said to him, "*Are you the **teacher** of Israel and do not understand these things?*"

John 8:4 NASB they *said to Him, "**teacher**, this woman has been caught in adultery, in the very act.

John 11:28 NASB When she had said this, she went away and called Mary her sister, saying secretly, "The **teacher** is here and is calling for you."

John 13:13 NASB "*You call Me **teacher** and Lord; and you are right, for so I am.*"

John 13:14 NASB "*If I then, the Lord and the **teacher**, washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.*"

John 20:16 NASB Jesus *said to her, "*Mary!*" She turned and *said to Him in Hebrew, "Rabboni!" (which means, **teacher**).

Acts 5:34 NASB But a Pharisee named Gamaliel, a **teacher** of the Law, respected by all the people, stood up in the Council and gave orders to put the men outside for a short time.

Romans 2:20 NASB a corrector of the foolish, a **teacher** of the immature, having in the Law the embodiment of knowledge and of the truth,

1 Timothy 2:7 NASB For this I was appointed a preacher and an apostle (I am telling the truth, I am not lying) as a **teacher** of the Gentiles in faith and truth.

2 Timothy 1:11 NASB for which I was appointed a preacher and an apostle and a **teacher**.

Instruct [15 verses, 15 matches]

1 Samuel 12:23 NASB "Moreover, as for me, far be it from me that I should sin against the LORD by

ceasing to pray for you; but I will **instruct** you in the good and right way.

Nehemiah 9:20 NASB "You gave Your good Spirit to **instruct** them, Your manna You did not withhold from their mouth, And You gave them water for their thirst.

Job 27:11 NASB "I will **instruct** you in the power of God; What is with the Almighty I will not conceal.

Job 38:3 NASB "Now gird up your loins like a man, And I will ask you, and you **instruct** Me!

Job 40:7 NASB "Now gird up your loins like a man; I will ask you, and you **instruct** Me.

Job 42:4 NASB 'Hear, now, and I will speak; I will ask You, and You **instruct** me.'

Psalms 25:12 NASB Who is the man who fears the LORD? He will **instruct** him in the way he should choose.

Psalms 32:8 NASB I will **instruct** you and teach you in the way which you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you.

Song of Solomon 8:2 NASB "I would lead you *and* bring you Into the house of my mother, who used to **instruct** me; I would give you spiced wine to drink from the juice of my pomegranates.

Micah 3:11 NASB Her leaders pronounce judgment for a bribe, Her priests **instruct** for a price And her prophets divine for money. Yet they lean on the LORD saying, "Is not the LORD in our midst? Calamity will not come upon us."

1 Corinthians 2:16 NASB For WHO HAS KNOWN THE MIND OF THE LORD, THAT HE WILL **instruct** HIM? But we have the mind of Christ.

1 Corinthians 14:19 NASB however, in the church I desire to speak five words with my mind so that I may **instruct** others also, rather than ten thousand words in a tongue.

1 Timothy 1:3 NASB As I urged you upon my departure for Macedonia, remain on at Ephesus so that you may **instruct** certain men not to teach strange doctrines,

1 Timothy 6:17 NASB **instruct** those who are rich in this present world not to be conceited or to fix their hope on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly supplies us with all things to enjoy.

1 Timothy 6:18 NASB **instruct** *them* to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share,

Instructs [4 verses, 4 matches]

Psalms 16:7 NASB I will bless the LORD who has counseled me; Indeed, my mind **instructs** me in the night.

Psalms 25:8 NASB Good and upright is the LORD; Therefore He **instructs** sinners in the way.

Proverbs 16:23 NASB The heart of the wise **instructs** his mouth And adds persuasiveness to his lips.

Isaiah 28:26 NASB For his God **instructs** and teaches him properly.

Instructing [4 verses, 4 matches]

Matthew 10:5 NASB These twelve Jesus sent out after **instructing** them: "Do not go in *the way of the Gentiles, and do not enter any city of the Samaritans*;

Acts 23:22 NASB So the commander let the young man go, **instructing** him, "Tell no one that you have notified me of these things."

Acts 23:30 NASB "When I was informed that there would be a plot against the man, I sent him to you at once, also **instructing** his accusers to bring charges against him before you."

Titus 2:12 NASB **instructing** us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age,

Tutor [2 verses, 2 matches]

Galatians 3:24 NASB Therefore the Law has become our **tutor** *to lead us* to Christ, so that we may be

justified by faith.

Galatians 3:25 NASB But now that faith has come, we are no longer under a **tutor**.

Tutors [1 verse, 1 match]

1 Corinthians 4:15 NASB For if you were to have countless **tutors** in Christ, yet *you would not have* many fathers, for in Christ Jesus I became your father through the gospel.

Tutored [1 verse, 1 match]

1 Chronicles 27:32 NASB Also Jonathan, David's uncle, *was* a counselor, a man of understanding, and a scribe; and Jehiel the son of Hachmoni **tutored** the king's sons.

Demonstrate [4 verses, 4 matches]

Romans 3:25 NASB whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. *This was* to **demonstrate** His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed;

Romans 9:17 NASB For the Scripture says to Pharaoh, "FOR THIS VERY PURPOSE I RAISED YOU UP, TO **demonstrate** MY POWER IN YOU, AND THAT MY NAME MIGHT BE PROCLAIMED THROUGHOUT THE WHOLE EARTH."

Romans 9:22 NASB What if God, although willing to **demonstrate** His wrath and to make His power known, endured with much patience vessels of wrath prepared for destruction?

1 Timothy 1:16 NASB Yet for this reason I found mercy, so that in me as the foremost, Jesus Christ might **demonstrate** His perfect patience as an example for those who would believe in Him for eternal life.

Demonstrates [3 verses, 3 matches]

Ecclesiastes 10:3 NASB Even when the fool walks along the road, his sense is lacking and he **demonstrates** to everyone *that* he is a fool.

Romans 3:5 NASB But if our unrighteousness **demonstrates** the righteousness of God, what shall we say? The God who inflicts wrath is not unrighteous, is He? (I am speaking in human terms.)

Romans 5:8 NASB But God **demonstrates** His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Demonstrating [1 verses, 1 matches]

Acts 18:28 NASB for he powerfully refuted the Jews in public, **demonstrating** by the Scriptures that Jesus was the Christ.

Demonstrated [1 verse, 1 match]
