### Reflections

The psalmist again contrasts those who faithfully keep God's word and those who don't, resulting in the salvation of those who persevere in keeping God's word.

161—perseverance in the face of persecution

162-treasuring God's Word

163-falsehood contrasted with God's word

164-daily worship

165-peace found in keeping God's word

166-salvation found in keeping God's word

167-keeping God's word becomes second nature

168-Nothing is hidden from God

The treasures found in God's word are not necessarily material, yet some people might gain riches by making wise decisions, but the real riches are found in the worship of God that is seen in our daily lives and in faithfully keeping God's covenant with us.
