H2617  *hesed*: A masculine noun indicating kindness, lovingkindness, mercy, goodness, faithfulness, love, acts of kindness. This aspect of God is one of several important features of His character: truth; faithfulness; mercy; steadfastness; justice; righteousness; goodness. The classic text for understanding the significance of this word is Psalm 136 where it is used twenty-six times to proclaim that God's

kindness and love are eternal. The psalmist made it clear that God's kindness and faithfulness serves as the foundation for His actions and His character: it underlies His goodness ([Psa 136:1](#)); it supports His unchallenged position as God and Lord ([Psa 136:2-3](#)); it is the basis for His great and wondrous acts in creation ([Psa 136:4-9](#)) and delivering and redeeming His people from Pharaoh and the Red Sea ([Psa 136:10-15](#)); the reason for His guidance in the desert ([Psa 136:16](#)); His gift of the land to Israel and defeat of their enemies ([Psa 136:17-22](#)); His ancient as well as His continuing deliverance of His people ([Psa 136:23-25](#)); His rulership in heaven ([Psa 136:26](#)). The entire span of creation to God's redemption, preservation, and permanent establishment is touched upon in this psalm. It all happened, is happening, and will continue to happen because of the Lord's covenant faithfulness and kindness.

The other more specific uses of the term develop the ideas contained in Psalm 136 in greater detail. Because of His kindness, He meets the needs of His creation by delivering them from enemies and despair ([Gen 19:19](#); [Exo 15:13](#); [Psa 109:26](#); [Jer 31:3](#)); He preserves their lives and redeems them from sin ([Psa 51:1](#) [3]; [Psa 86:13](#)). As Psalm 136 demonstrates, God's kindness is abundant, exceedingly great, without end, and good ([Exo 34:6](#); [Num 14:19](#); [Psa 103:8](#); [Psa 109:21](#); [Jer 33:11](#)). The plural of the noun indicates the many acts of God on behalf of His people ([Gen 32:10](#) [11]; [Isa 63:7](#)). He is the covenant-keeping God who maintains kindness and mercy ([Deu 7:9](#)) to those who love Him.

People are to imitate God. They are to display kindness and faithfulness toward each other ([1Sa 20:15](#); [Psa 141:5](#); [Pro 19:22](#)), especially toward the poor, weak, and needy ([Job 6:14](#); [Pro 20:28](#)). Israel was to show kindness and faithfulness toward the Lord but often failed. In its youth, Israel showed faithfulness to God, but its devotion lagged later ([Jer 2:2](#)). It was not constant ([Hos 6:4](#)), appearing and leaving as the morning mist even though God desired this from His people more than sacrifices ([Hos 6:6](#); cf. [1Sa 15:22](#)). He looked for pious people ([Isa 57:1](#)) who would perform deeds of piety, faithfulness, and kindness ([2Ch 32:32](#); [2Ch 35:26](#); [Neh 13:14](#)); the Lord desired people who would maintain covenant loyalty and responsibility so that He could build His righteous community.

This word is used 240 times in the Old Testament, and is especially frequent in the Psalter. The term is one of the most important in the vocabulary of Old Testament theology and ethics.

The Septuagint nearly always renders *cheded* with *eleos* ("mercy"), and that usage is reflected in the New Testament. Modern translations, in contrast, generally prefer renditions close to the word "grace." KJV usually has "mercy," although "loving-kindness" (following Coverdale), "favor," and other translations also occur. RSV generally prefers "steadfast love." NIV often offers simply "love."

In general, one may identify three basic meanings of the word, which always interact: "strength," "steadfastness," and "love." Any understanding of the word that fails to suggest all three inevitably loses some of its richness. "Love" by itself easily becomes sentimentalized or universalized apart from the covenant. Yet "strength" or "steadfastness" suggests only the fulfillment of a legal or other obligation.

The word refers primarily to mutual and reciprocal rights and obligations between the parties of a relationship (especially Yahweh and Israel). But *cheded* is not only a matter of obligation; it is also of generosity. It is not only a matter of loyalty, but also of mercy. The weaker party seeks the protection and blessing of the patron and protector, but he may not lay absolute claim to it. The stronger party remains committed to his promise, but retains his freedom, especially with regard to the manner in which he will implement those promises. *Cheded* implies personal involvement and commitment in a relationship beyond the rule of law.

Marital love is often related to *cheded*. Marriage certainly is a legal matter, and there are legal sanctions for infractions. Yet the relationship, if sound, far transcends mere legalities. The prophet Hosea applies the analogy to Yahweh's *cheded* to Israel within the covenant (e.g., *Hos 2:21*). Hence, "devotion" is sometimes the single English word best capable of capturing the nuance of the original. The RSV attempts to bring this out by its translation, "steadfast love." Hebrew writers often underscored the element of steadfastness (or strength) by pairing *cheded* with *'emet* ("truth, reliability") and *'emunah* ("faithfulness").

Biblical usage frequently speaks of someone "doing," "showing," or "keeping" *cheded*. The concrete content of the word is especially evident when it is used in the plural. God's "mercies," "kindnesses," or "faithfulnesses" are His specific, concrete acts of redemption in fulfillment of His promise. An example appears in *Isa 55:3* : "...And I will make an everlasting covenant with you, even the sure mercies of David."

Cheded has both God and man as its subject. When man is the subject of *cheded*, the word usually describes the person's kindness or loyalty to another; cf. *2Sa 9:7* : "And David said...I will surely show thee [Mephibosheth] kindness for Jonathan thy father's sake...." Only rarely is the term applied explicitly to man's affection or fidelity toward God; the clearest example is probably *Jer 2:2* : "Go and cry in the ears of Jerusalem, saying, thus saith the Lord; I remember thee, the kindness of thy youth, the love of thine espousals, when thou wentest after me in the wilderness...."

Man exercises *cheded* toward various units within the community—toward family and relatives, but also to friends, guests, masters, and servants. *Cheded* toward the lowly and needy is often specified. The Bible prominently uses the term *cheded* to summarize and characterize a life of sanctification within, and in response to, the covenant. Thus, *Hos 6:6* states that God desires "mercy [RSV, "steadfast love"] and not sacrifice" (i.e., faithful living in addition to worship). Similarly, *Mic 6:8* features *cheded* in the prophets' summary of biblical ethics: "...and what doth the Lord require of thee, but...to love mercy.. .?"

Behind all these uses with man as subject, however, stand the repeated references to God's *cheded*. It is one of His most central characteristics. God's loving-kindness is offered to His people, who need redemption from sin, enemies, and troubles. A recurrent refrain describing God's nature is "abounding/plenteous in *cheded*" (*Exo 34:6*; *Neh 9:17*; *Psa 103:8*; *Jon 4:2*). The entire history of Yahweh's covenantal relationship with Israel can be summarized in terms of *cheded*. It is the one permanent element in the flux of covenantal history. Even the Creation is the result of God's *cheded*

(Psa 136:5-9). His love lasts for a "thousand generations" (Deu 7:9; cf. Deu 5:10 and Exo 20:6), indeed "forever" (especially in the refrains of certain psalms, such as Psalm 136).

Words used in synonymous parallelism with *cheded* help to define and explain it. The word most commonly associated with *cheded* is 'emet ("fidelity; reliability"): "...Let thy loving-kindness [*cheded*] and thy truth ['emet] continually preserve me." 'Emunah with a similar meaning is also common: "He hath remembered his mercy [*cheded*] and his truth ['emunah] toward the house of Israel...." This emphasis is especially appropriate when God is the subject, because His *cheded* is stronger and more enduring than man's. Etymological investigation suggests that *cheded*'s primitive significance may have been "strength" or "permanence." If so, a puzzling use of *cheded* in Isa 40:6 would be explained: "All flesh is grass, and all the goodliness thereof is as the flower of the field."

The association of *cheded* with "covenant" keeps it from being misunderstood as mere providence or love for all creatures; it applies primarily to God's particular love for His chosen and covenanted people. "Covenant" also stresses the reciprocity of the relationship; but since God's *cheded* is ultimately beyond the covenant, it will not ultimately be abandoned, even when the human partner is unfaithful and must be disciplined (Isa 54:8, Isa 54:10). Since its final triumph and implementation is eschatological, *cheded* can imply the goal and end of all salvation-history (Psa 85:7, Psa 85:10; Psa 130:7; Mic 7:20).

The proper noun Hacdiah (1Ch 3:20) is related to *cheded*. The name of Zerubbabel's son means "Yahweh is faithful/gracious," a fitting summary of the prophet's message.

B. Adjective.

chacid (H2623), "pious; devout; faithful; godly." The adjective *chacid*, derived from *cheded*, is often used to describe the faithful Israelite. God's *cheded* provides the pattern, model, and strength by which the life of the *chacid* is to be directed. One reference to the "godly" man appears in Psa 12:1: "Help, Lord; for the godly man ceaseth; for the faithful fail from among the children of men." Usually a suffix or possessive pronoun referring to God is attached to the word, indicating His special attachment to those who pattern their lives after His: "O love the Lord, all ye his saints [literally, "His pious ones"; NASB, "His godly ones"]: for the Lord preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer" (Psa 31:23).

Following the Greek *hosios* and Latin *sanctus*, the KJV often renders the word "saint"-which must be understood in the sense of sanctification [dependent upon grace], not moralistically [of native goodness].

luv-ing-kind'nes (לֶחֶם, *ḥeṣedh*): "Lovingkindness" in the King James Version always represents this word (30 times), but of *ḥeṣedh* there are many other renderings, e.g. "mercy" (frequently), "kindness" (38), "goodness" (12). The word is derived from *ḥāṣadh*, meaning, perhaps, "to bend or bow oneself," "to incline oneself"; hence, "to be gracious or merciful." the English Revised Version has not many changes, but in the American Standard Revised Version "lovingkindness" is invariably employed when *ḥeṣedh* is used of God, and, as a rule, "kindness" when it is used of man, as in [Gen 21:23](#); [Jdg 1:24](#) (the King James Version "mercy," the Revised Version (British and American) "deal kindly"); [Rth 3:10](#); [2Ch 32:32](#); [2Ch 35:26](#) (the King James Version "goodness,"); margin "Hebrew: kindness" the Revised Version (British and American) "good deeds"); [Job 6:14](#), etc. Of the uses of the word as on man's part toward God, the only occurrences are: [Jer 2:2](#), "I remember for thee the *kindness* of thy youth, the love of

thine espousals,” etc.; [Hos 6:4](#), [Hos 6:6](#), “Your goodness (the Revised Version margin “or kindness”) is as a morning cloud,” “I desire goodness (the King James Version “mercy,” the Revised Version margin “Kindness”), and not sacrifice,” which last passage may denote kindness as toward man.

When used of God *ḥesedh* denotes, in general, “the Divine Love condescending to His creatures, more especially to sinners, in unmerited kindness” (Delitzsch). It is frequently associated with forgiveness, and is practically equivalent to “mercy” or “mercifulness” ([Exo 20:6](#)), “showing lovingkindness (the English Revised Version “mercy”) unto thousands of them that love me”; [Exo 34:6](#) f, “slow to anger, and abundant in lovingkindness (the English Revised Version “plenteous in mercy”)”; ([Exo 34:7](#)) “keeping lovingkindness (the English Revised Version “mercy”) for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin” (compare [Num 14:18](#)); [Mic 7:18](#), “He retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth in lovingkindness” (the English Revised Version “mercy”). This quality in Yahweh was one by which He sought to bind His people to Himself. It is greatly magnified in the Old Testament, highly extolled and gloried in, in many of the psalms (Ps 136 has the constant refrain, “For his lovingkindness endureth forever”). In [Deu 7:12](#) it is associated with the covenant, and in [2Sa 7:15](#) with the covenant with David (compare [Isa 55:3](#), etc.). It was something that could always be relied on.

Being such an essential and distinctive quality of God, the prophets taught that it should also characterize His people. It is part of the Divine requirement in [Mic 6:8](#), “to love kindness” (compare [Zec 7:9](#), “Show kindness and compassion every man to his brother”). The want of it in the nation was a cause of Yahweh's controversy with them, e.g. [Hos 4:1](#), “There is no truth, nor goodness (*ḥesedh*) (the King James Version and the English Revised Version “mercy”), nor knowledge of God in the land”; [Hos 12:6](#), “Therefore turn thou to thy God: keep kindness (the King James Version and the English Revised Version “mercy”) and justice, and wait for thy God continually.” Cheyne (*Encyclopedia Biblica*) regards *ḥesedh* as denoting paternal affection on God's part, answered by filial and loyal affection and brotherly love on man's part (*philadelphia* in the New Testament).

The word “lovingkindness” does not occur in the New Testament, but as its equivalents we have such terms as “mercy” “goodness,” “kindness,” “brotherly love” (see special articles).
