

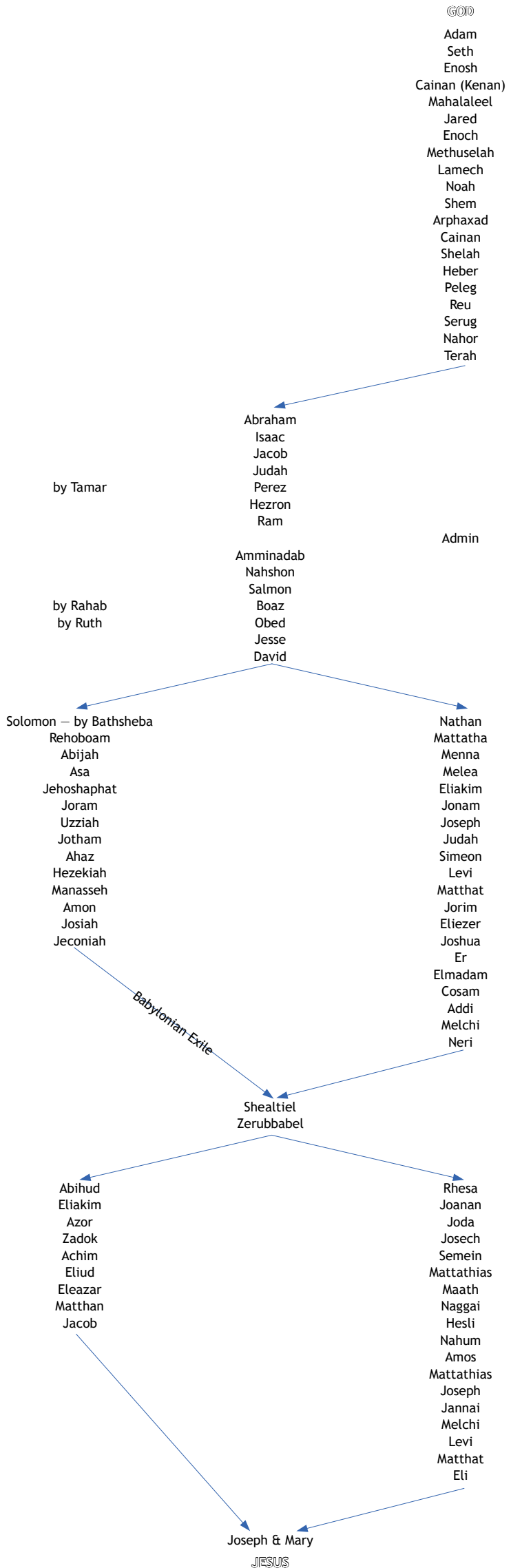

Left column - items that are unique to Matthew.

- Consists of 3 groups of 14: Abraham to David, David to Exile in Babylon, Exile in Babylon to Jesus (1:17).

- Matthew also includes 4 women other than Mary in his genealogy – Tamar(1:3), Rahab & Ruth (1:5), Bathsheba (1:6) – of whom three were non-Jewish.

Right column - items that are unique to Luke.

Center column - items that are found in both.

Tamar was from the region of Enaim (Gen 38)

Admin not listed in Matthew

Rahab was from Jericho (Joshua 2)
Ruth was from Moab (Ruth 1)

Bathsheba, probably Jewish
